For some users Windows 10 is now blocking Audacity from using the microphone, on the basis of privacy settings.

After upgrading to version 1803, some users have been reporting that the microphone is getting detected, but it doesn't pick up any sound.

In order to get around this issue, Microsoft recommends that you need to enable the microphone in your Privacy settings using these steps:

- 1) Open Settings
- 2) Click on Privacy
- 3) Click on Microphone
- 4) Turn on the Allow apps to access your microphone toggle switch.

## CAN'T ACTIVATE PHP SERVER IN BRAVE BROWSER Win10 64BITS - SOLVED

1 open "Command Promp"

2 Type: cmd

3 Follow these steps:

To watch the version of PHP type: `php -v`

To create a server type: `php -s localhost:4000`

Then you will get a message like:

`[Wed Jun1010:49:42 2020] PHP 7.4.6 Development Server`

`(http://localhost:4000) started`

4 Then go to Brave Browser and copy and paste the localhost:4000 in the url, do not write it down, you have to paste it from the command promp otherwise it will not work

## **CAN'T START MYSQL, PORT3306 BUSY MAMP WIN10 64BITS - SOLVED**

Browser: Brave

- 1.press Ctrl+Alt+Del and open Task Manager.
- 2.Open the "Processes" list and Check for "show all processes" under the list of processes. If you don't see any such option, don't worry! as sometimes administrator permission is required to show some processes.

3. Now, when you click on "show all processes" button, all the process will be displayed.
4. Now, switch to "services" tab in the task manager, and a list of services will be displayed. Now look for a service named "filename.de" <-- filename that was displayed in the error message in xampp.
5. When you find that service, 'right-click', and then click in option.. GoTo Process.
6. You will be redirected to the "Processes" tab with focus on a process corresponding to that service. 'Right-Click' and then click on "end process tree".
7. Now, the issue has been solved! But might have to do the same thing again when you restart your PC. So it is best to keep your PC in sleep-mode.
8. Otherwise, to solve this issue permanently, open "msconfig" and uncheck that particular process from the services list and click on apply. and you can restart your system.

- Make sure you are running MySql on 3306 and if you have configured make sure to state it while making a connection
